Using the brand-new **American Community Survey (ACS)**, we have compiled detailed descriptions (profiles) of the demographic, socioeconomic, and housing characteristics for the State of Michigan, for 26 counties and 22 cities/ townships, and for 12 PUMAs – groups of counties in rural Michigan. There are six pages, or tables, of data for each geographic area. The tables are similar to those in our 2000 Census profile series.

Examples:

- ★ **General Population Characteristics:**
Total population, population by race/Hispanic origin, household relationship
- ★ **Social Characteristics:**
Foreign born, school enrollment, educational attainment, language
- ★ **Income and Poverty Characteristics:**
Household income, income sources, earnings, poverty status
- ★ **Labor Force Characteristics:**
Labor force status, participation rates, occupation, industry, place of work
- ★ **General Housing Characteristics:**
Count of housing units, own/rent status, units in structure, years of residence
- ★ **Selected Housing Characteristics:**
Number of rooms, rent, housing value, housing costs as a % of income

The geographic areas included in the profile are those of 65,000 population or more, and are the smallest areas for which ACS data are now available. You may order the book using the attached form, which may also be downloaded from the SEMCC web site, www.semcc.org.
